

## SAJGA Booth Trophy & Ringgenberg Trophy Points Criteria

Only SAJGA members will be awarded performance-based points used towards the Booth Trophy and Ringgenberg Trophy. Points are earned throughout the season by participating in junior golf events deemed as "Trophy Point Eligible" by the SAJGA Tournament Committee. Events are assigned to one, of three, point levels. Members participating in "Trophy Point Eligible" SAJGA Tournaments are awarded points in the following manner:

**BONUS**

*Any player in the SAJGA 13-18 Age Divisions that volunteers in an SAJGA 12 & Under event, will receive an additional 10 points added to their Player of the Year total*

*\*= Points will be awarded to SAJGA players in relation to other SAJGA players ONLY*

In the event of a tie, points will be added up and divided by the number of players tied. For example, two players tie for 4th Place (level 3), 6 points + 5 points = 11 points then divide by 2 (players). Each player is awarded 5.5 points.

If a player is disqualified from an event for cheating or other inappropriate behavior, they are ineligible for the Booth Trophy or the Ringgenberg Trophy, for the calendar year in which the disqualification takes place.

*If a member moves up a Player Division, throughout the season, their points will start from zero in the new division.*

### ***End of Season Tie Breakers***

1. Number of 1st Place finishes in the current division
2. Number of 2nd Place finishes in the current division
3. Number of 3rd Place finishes in the current division
4. Head to Head competition in the last event of the season
5. Head to Head competition in the next to last event of the season
