

## **Three Golf Web Sites for 2011**

**The first web site is [WWW. WAYNEDEFRANCESCO. COM](http://WWW.WAYNEDEFRANCESCO.COM)**

**Wayne has a number of video clips of golf swings of well known accomplished golfers. He has auditory comments on the swing, and he draws various lines using golf swing analysis software. On the web site, if you click on "VIDEO", you will see dozens of golf swings under the categories : "INSTRUCTIONAL VIDEOS", "TOUR PLAYERS", "LEGENDS OF GOLF" , and "AS SEEN ON TV". As you watch the swings of these golfers, you will see certain common characteristics that are found in the swings of many great golfers.**

**On the web site, if you click on "PLAYER RESOURCES", and then click on "BLOG", and then click on "page 2", you will see video clips of the one plane swing and the two plane swing from the face view and from down the line, as well as an analysis of Matt Kuchar's swing. Click on "page 3" for more on Matt Kuchar. Click on "page 4" for a video on long hitting Alvaro Quiros from Spain. A number of excellent DVDs on the one plane swing and the two plane swing are available on this web site when you click on "shop" and then click on "On-line store".**

**The third web site is [WWW. V1GOLFACADEMY. COM](http://WWW.V1GOLFACADEMY.COM)**

**On this web site, you can download a free version of the V1 Home Basic golf swing analysis software, or you can pay \$39.95 for a more advanced version of the software called V1 Home Premium. You can take pictures of your own swing from the face view and from down the line using a point and shoot digital camera, download the swings to your computer, and then watch your swing in slow motion using the golf swing analysis software.**

**By watching the swings of great golfers on the first two web sites, you will get an idea what to look for in a good golf swing. By watching slow motion digital video clips of your own swing , you can compare your own swing to the swings of great golfers and make adjustments if needed. This should lead to "better golf using modern technology" !**
